Reminder: Due to property insurance restrictions beyond our control, we cannot allow "kiddie pools" or kid play pools on the premises. Grills must be kept away from building and to the back of the property.

- Trash around units should be cleaned and maintained by the tenant, regardless of where it came from. If housing authority staff has to pick up trash around your unit, you will be charged a pick-up fee.

Lovin' Lunches to Resume June 2nd, Serving Butts County Children All Summer!

During June and July of last year, local nonprofit *Lovin' Lunches* delivered an impressive **17,544 meals** to children in Butts County.

Volunteers from local churches, community groups, and businesses joined forces to prepare peanut butter and jelly sandwiches, assemble lunches, and deliver them Monday through Friday. The program is led by volunteer coordinator **Ms. Harileen Conner**, who calls it a true team effort.

This year's program will kick off on June 2nd and run through the end of July, continuing its mission to ensure no child goes hungry during the summer months.
