





Healthy Start

What is the Healthy Start program?

Healthy Start is a free program that supports women and their families before, during and after pregnancy by addressing their physical and emotional health needs. This program is designed to improve overall health outcomes for women and expectant families by collaborating between the clinical setting and community partners. This enhances patient care by integrating local resources to ensure a more comprehensive approach to health and wellness.

Who's eligible to participate?

Expectant mothers, women of childbearing age, fathers, partners and children under 18 months of age are eligible for services. There is no financial component to qualify.

How much does it cost?

There is no cost. The Healthy Start program is covered by a grant and the resources and services are free to participants.

What kind of services are available?

- Pregnancy and postnatal care, including doula services
- Childbirth education and parenting classes
- Breastfeeding support and education
- Care coordination, including transportation
- Immunizations
- Nutritional guidance

How do I enroll in Healthy Start?
